- Re: Discussion of Regional Recreation Center Feasibility Study

Date: February 12, 2024

Over 30 years ago in 1993, the Town of Telluride conducted a "Recreation Survey", which indicated significant local support for a recreation center at that time, including support from user groups such as gymnastics club, school district, Film Festival, theatre groups, and others. That survey was then followed up by a 1996 "Community Center Feasibility Study" which developed a program and preliminary design for a regionally scaled Rec Center (including gym, lap pool, family pool, track, child care, etc.) estimated to cost \$7.8M at the time, with a projected annual cost recovery around 70% at full staffing.

Residents in the Telluride community and wider region have consistently continued to express the need for a regional recreation, and during several Intergovernmental meetings in 2023, the group discussed a desire to begin moving forward on an updated Rec Center Feasibility Study for the region. To that end, the Town of Telluride Council has adopted the pursuit of such a study in their 2024 Goals and Objectives. Given that the Town of Telluride and the Town of Mountain Village have now appropriated approximately \$25,000 <u>each</u> in their 2024 budgets to go toward such a study, now is the time to solicit interest from additional agencies and districts who may also wish to be involved in such a study as well.

It is estimated that upward of \$100,000 may be necessary to fund a robust regional recreation center feasibility study which would ideally include a building site alternatives analysis, survey of interest group needs, desired recreation program and preliminary facility design to begin estimating construction costs. To solicit such a study, a Request for Proposals (RFP) would need to be issued which follows the guidelines of those jurisdictions helping fund a feasibility study. Additional discussion and direction from elected officials and local Special District leaders is desired.
